GEELONG MOTOR SPORTS CLUB & WESTERN DISTRICTS CAR CLUB AVALON MOTORKHANA ROUND 7 06 October 2024 SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. THE EVENT

The Event, a **Club Motorkhana**, shall be known as the GMSC & WDCC Avalon Motorkhana Round 7, and will hereafter be called the Event. The Event will be held on the 06/10/2024 which will also be referred to as the "Sunday of the Event". The Event is open to members of Clubs affiliated with Motorsport Australia in Victoria.

Note that the above-designated Officials will be considered the **Judge of Fact** for all matters pertaining to the Event.

5. AUTHORITY

Held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletin issued. The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

6. PLACE AND DATE

The Event will be held at the !Geelong Motor Sports Complex", on the Sunday of the Event at the corner of the Princess Hwy & Beach Rd, Avalon. Current Club Membership Card, Motorsport Australia Licence, and Motorsport Australia Vehicle Log Book (if issued) <u>MUST</u> be presented at Scrutiny. Gates open at **08:00am**. Scrutiny will be conducted at the Venue and will commence **8:30am AND CLOSE AT 9:30am**. A compulsory Drivers Briefing will be at **9:45am**.

Official Runs will commence at 10:00am. BYO snacks and non-alcoholic drinks.

You MUST be in the queue for Scrutiny by 8:45am. Motorsport Australia Vehicle Self-Scrutiny Form Accepted

7. ENTRIES

- (a) Entries will open on the publication of these Regulations and close at **9:00am** on the morning of the event. Entries are to be lodged at registration prior to the commencement of the event.
- (b) The Entry Fee is \$25.00. Drivers should enter and pay on the day.
- (c) An Entry will only be termed valid when a current Motorsport Australia Licence and Club Membership is presented, and payment has been received. Payment can be made on the day.
- (d) There will be a maximum of four Drivers per Vehicle
- (e A maximum of 30 Entries will be accepted, in order of receipt
- (f) The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entries in accordance with the NCR.

8. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

9. CLASSES

A - 2WD Front Wheel Drive

B – 2WD Rear Wheel Drive

J – Junior (12 to 18 years)

L - Ladies

S - 4WD & Specials

Any classes that do not receive a minimum of 3 Entries will be merged into one Open Class. Class J will run regardless of the number of Entries.

10. STARTING ORDER

Starting order will be determined by ballot or by direction of the Officials. In the case of shared Vehicles, Drivers will be spaced several Vehicles apart to allow changeovers with minimal disruption to the Event.

11. DRIVERS

Drivers must hold a Motorsport Australia Speed/Speed Junior Licence or superior.

12. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

Vehicles must comply with Motorsport Australia Group 4H, Schedule A of the Motorsport Australia Manual. All Vehicles defined as Specials by 4H must be fitted with Roll – Over Protection as

per Schedule J. Competitors must produce a valid and current Motorsport Australia Competition Licence and Club Membership Card of a Motorsport Australia-Affiliated Car Club and Log Book (if issued) at Document Check.

13. SPECIAL NOTES.

- (1) **Safety Helmets** (recommended) and Apparel must conform to Schedule D requirements (eg AS 1698) and be worn whilst Competing (for specials).
- (3) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G.
- (4) All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Exhaust noise is to be restricted to 95dB (A)

- (5) Notwithstanding the requirements of Schedule I (refer to Technical Appendix of the Motorsport Australia Manual) all Drivers **must** wear, while competing, at least a Lap-Type Seat Belt, properly adjusted. Drivers of Vehicles registered with Motorsport Australia as Historic Cars are exempted from this requirement.
- (6) Clothing should be of a Fire Resistant nature. For further details, please refer to Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

Any breaches of these Supplementary Regulations will be dealt with in the same manner as breaches of all other Regulations pertaining to the Event.

(7) All Vehicles:

Only Passenger Vehicle road tyres permitted. Reconditioned tyres may be permitted at the discretion of the Scrutineers. Rally tyres, Motor Sport type design, competition, winter tread, off road, terrain (of any category) or tyres marked not for road use are NOT permitted.

(8) At the discretion of the Clerk of Course, a challenge time trial with a flag starter may be incorporated in the event.

14. EVENT LAYOUT

- (a) The Event will be run on a bitumen surface defined by Witches Hats, Flags Bunting and Tyres, with Tests/Courses drawn from the Motorsports Australia Motorkhana Test Book.
- (b) The Event will comprise a minimum of three (4) Tests with each Test being conducted twice.

15. RUNNING DETAIL

Results will be determined by adding the Driver's Runs. Timing will be by hand held stopwatches. Timing **must** commence when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated Start Line and **must** cease when the leading point of the vehicle crosses the designated Finish Line. The designated Finish Line **must** be not less than 500mm and not more than one metre behind the front of the finish garage.

16. STARTING PROCEDURE

Competitors will line up in order designated on the day and will move onto the Course start garage defined by cones/bollards when signalled by the Start Marshal. Timing will commence when the front of the vehicle passes garage start line.

17. FINISH PROCEDURE

A Run is completed once the front of the vehicle has passed through the Start/Finish Line and has come to a complete stop within the garage. Vehicles are then to proceed immediately off the course. The maximum Speed Limit in the paddock area is 10 km/h.

18. TERMINATION, POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR or if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason.

In the Event of a **Total Fire Ban or High Fire Danger** being declared or **heavy rain**, the Event **WILL** be cancelled.

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR to commencement for more than 24 hours, the Entry Fees shall be refunded in full.

19. AWARDS

2024 Championships

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Outright - points toward end of year championship award 1st in each class J (min 3 entries/class) - points toward end of year championship award.

20. GMSC & WDCC Avalon Motorkhana Championship

- (1) This Event shall form a part of the 2024 GMSC & WDCC Motorkhana Championship.
- (2) The Championship will consist of ALL Competitive GMSC & WDCC Motorkhana Events held in the 2024 calendar year regardless of the number of Events held.
- (3) Points will be awarded to the top 10 finishes outright:

 $1^{st} = 11pnts, 2^{nd} = 10pnts, 3^{rd} = 9pnts....... 9^{th} = 3pnts, 10^{th} = 2pnt$

- (4) All Competitors who finish lower than 10th place will receive 1 Championship Point as long as they compete in a minimum of Half the Tests on the Day.
- (5) The Championship will be divided into Juniors (under 18 at the 1st Event of the year) and Open.

21. INTEGRITY

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and !vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia"s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia"s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au. Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

23. PENALTIES

All penalties will be applied in accordance with the Motorkhana Standing Regulations.

24. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with the NCR and accompanied by the appropriate Fee.
