1. THE EVENT

The Event, shall be known as the Women's Introduction to Motorsport and will hereafter be called the Event. The Event will be held on the 10/11/2024 which will also be referred to as the "Sunday of the Event". The Event is open to Women and gender non-conforming only from age 16 and up.

5. AUTHORITY

Held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletin issued. The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

6. PLACE AND DATE

The Event will be held at the "Geelong Motor Sports Complex", on the Sunday of the Event at the corner of the Princess Hwy & Beach Rd, Avalon (55 Beach Rd Avalon). at the Venue and will commence 8:00am and close at 12.30pm for session 1, and session 2 will commence at 1:00pm and close at 5.00pm. A compulsory Drivers Briefing will be at 8:15am for session 1, and 1:15pm for Session 2.

Snacks and non-alcoholic drinks will be provided for both groups.

You MUST be ready to sign on at 8:00am for session 1 and 1:00pm for session 2.

7. ENTRIES

- (a) Entries will open on the publication of these Regulations and close at 8:**00am** on the morning of the event. Entries are to be lodged at registration prior to the commencement of the event.
- (b) The Entry Fee is **\$30.00 per driver**. Drivers should enter via the separate form (attached to email) and pay via direct deposit to:

Alternatively, cash will be accepted on the day.

- (c) An Entry will only be termed valid when payment has been received and an entry form completed. Payment is preferred in advance but can be made on the day.
- (d) There will be a maximum of four Drivers per Vehicle/
- (e) A maximum of 15 Entries for each session will be accepted, in order of receipt
- (f) The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entries in accordance with the NCR.

8. INSURANCE

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

10. STARTING ORDER

Starting order will be determined by ballot or by direction of the Officials. In the case of shared Vehicles, Drivers will be spaced several Vehicles apart to allow changeovers with minimal disruption to the Event.

11. DRIVERS

No experience is required.

12. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

Vehicles must be presented in a safe to operate condition and will undergo a basic scrutineering check by officials at the venue. All loose items must be removed from the interior of the vehicle.

The club has available to loan one Nissan Pulsar manual and One Mitsubishi Lancer Auto, upon special request for those that don't have access to a vehicle. Vehicle will be supplied in a safe and ready to operate condition.

13. SPECIAL NOTES.

- (1) All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Exhaust noise is to be restricted to 95dB (A)
- (5) Notwithstanding the requirements of Schedule I (refer to General Requirements for Vehicles and Drivers of the Motorsport Australia Manual) all Drivers **must** wear, while competing, at least a Lap-Type Seat Belt, properly adjusted. Drivers of

Vehicles registered with Motorsport Australia as Historic Cars are exempted from this requirement.

(6) Clothing should be of a Fire Resistant nature. For further details, please refer to Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.

Any breaches of these Supplementary Regulations will be dealt with in the same manner as breaches of all other Regulations pertaining to the Event.

(7) All Vehicles:

Only Passenger Vehicle road tyres permitted. Reconditioned tyres may be permitted at the discretion of the Scrutineers. Rally tyres, Motor Sport type design, competition, winter tread, off road, terrain (of any category) or tyres marked not for road use are NOT permitted.

(8) At the discretion of the Clerk of Course, a challenge time trial with a flag starter may be incorporated in the event.

14. EVENT LAYOUT

(a) The Event will be run on a bitumen surface defined by Witches Hats, Bunting and Tyres, with Tests/Courses drawn from the Motorsports Australia Motorkhana Test Book.

15. RUNNING DETAIL

There will be up to three different activities conducted on the bitumen pad for each session, with a final motorkhana test that may be timed.

16. STARTING PROCEDURE

Competitors will line up in order designated on the day and will move onto the Course start garage defined by cones/bollards when signalled by the Start Marshal.

17. FINISH PROCEDURE

A Run is completed once the front of the vehicle has passed through the Start/Finish Line and has come to a complete stop within the garage. Vehicles are then to proceed immediately off the course. The maximum Speed Limit in the paddock area is 10 km/h.

18. TERMINATION, POSTPONEMENT OR ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION

The Organisers reserve the right to stop the Event at any time if they consider it necessary, in the interests of safety or for any other reason.

In the Event of a **Total Fire Ban or High Fire Danger** being declared or **heavy rain**, the Event **WILL** be cancelled.

The Organiser reserves the right to abandon, postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR to commencement for more than 24 hours, the Entry Fees shall be refunded in full.

19. AWARDS

The Clerk of Course may choose to allocate awards on the day.

21. INTEGRITY, ALCOHOL, DRUGS & OTHER SUBSTANCES

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.

23. PENALTIES

Any act of reckless driving or behaviour may lead to termination of a participant's entry, or exclusion for a period of time as determined by the Clerk of Course. A verbal warning will be issued in the first instance.

24. Lunch & Food Allergies

Nibbles will be provided, but please let us know prior to the event if there are any food allergies or dietary restrictions.
